- Our wonderful foster closet. It is located above the Welcome Center and has provided clothes and personal care for more than 150 children that have been placed into the fostering system.
- We have a fund at our church that you can donate to or there are specific items put in the Belltower periodically as needs arise that you can purchase.
- This year our church fed the Department of Social Services employees and caseworkers in an effort to show our support and appreciation of all they do for these children.
- We also provided Christmas help for 40 foster children through the Toys for Tots Angel Tree project.
- We provided duffle bags for approximately 80 foster children to help them as they transition from one place to another
