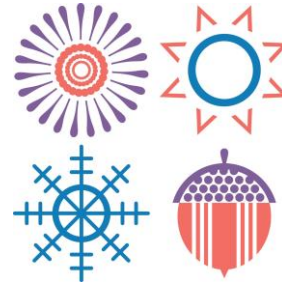

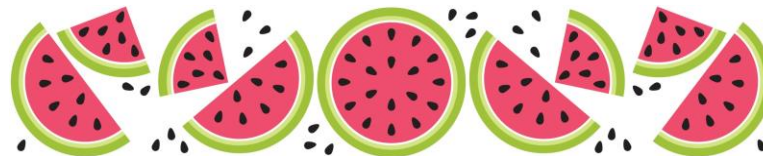
PERFECT ORDER
