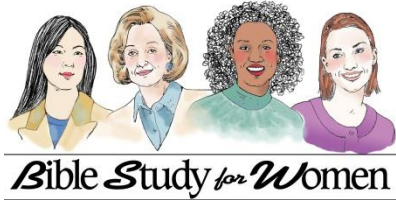


MINISTER OF MUSIC SEARCH COMMITTEE

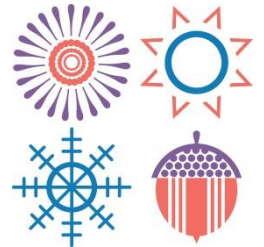
