2019 Missions Facts

 More than 800 internationals, representing 35 countries, enter South Carolina Baptist Convention churches each week to learn English as a Second Language. Twenty-five professions of faith and nine baptisms were recorded among these students from around the world.

 Thirty-four churches and associations received funds from the Global Hunger Relief Offering to help alleviate hunger in their communities. One hundred twenty-five thousand individuals were fed. Seventeen professions of faith and 19 baptisms were recorded, as a result of hunger ministries.

 College students and leaders attended Converge Collegiate Conference, February 1-3, 2019 at Kingston Plantation in Myrtle Beach. *Valued* was the focus of the weekend for the 963 in attendance, helping them see how great God's love is for them.


