

WORSHIP ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

1. We continue to emphasize that our first priority is the safety and health of our congregation and staff.
2. We continue to meet in the sanctuary on Sundays at 9:00 a.m.
3. We continue to live-stream the 9:00 a.m. service so that those who cannot attend will be able to worship along with us from anywhere and at any time.
4. We continue to strongly encourage you to follow the example of our church staff and wear a facial covering before and after worship while in the sanctuary. Of course, you can choose to wear your mask the entire time.
5. We continue to strongly encourage you to practice social distancing, refrain from physical contact (handshakes, hugs, etc.), and sit only on designated pews. Sanctuary seating will be limited, therefore our ushers will be glad to assist you as you enter and exit the sanctuary. Seating will be available on every other pew. Members of the same family can sit together; however, social distancing must be maintained with other worshippers.
6. We continue to screen our volunteers by taking their temperature with a forehead thermometer as they arrive.
7. We continue to have hand sanitizer available to use as you arrive and leave.
8. We continue to have offering plates at the Sanctuary entrances/exits for you to place your offerings in as you enter or exit.
9. We continue to respectfully ask those who are in the high-risk categories, who are sick or have a fever and those who have any COVID-19 symptoms to please stay at home. Also, if you have been exposed to COVID-19 in the past 14 days, please do not attend.
10. We continue to be excited about gathering for worship and want to make our time together wonderfully meaningful for everyone. We ask for your continued

prayers, support, patience and cooperation as we worship in our sanctuary.
