

DEACON NOMINATION

On October 25th, the church will start the deacon nomination process. With our current situation with limited attendance at services, the AMC wanted to give everyone a chance to participate in electing our new Deacons. On Wednesday, October 7th, ballots will be mailed to each household of our current membership. There should be enough ballots in the mailing for every family member that is a FBC member. You can nominate up to 6 people on the ballot. There are three ways to turn in your ballots. First, there will be a stamped, self-addressed envelope that you can use to return the ballots to the church. They will need to arrive by Thursday, October 22nd in order to be counted. Second, you may bring your ballots by the church office during business hours up to the 22nd, and third, a ballot box will be located in the vestibule if you want to bring them to a Sunday service on the 11th, 19th or 25th. There will be ballots available on the 25th in case someone still needs to complete their nomination ballot.

AD HOC WORSHIP TEAM

The Music Team met in September concerning how to move forward with the opening created by Robert Beaver retiring. They were unanimous in wanting to go slow in filling the position based on the current situation with CoVid-19. Also they wanted to utilize the talented musicians that we have in our church to present any special music we may do during this time. The Music Team will review again once we are 100% with all of our services capacities and activities.

In the interim, they requested an Ad Hoc Worship Team to:

- ~ Coordinate and plan Sunday worship services with our Pastor
- ~ Coordinate ensembles, solos, duets and other musical groups
- ~ Select hymns and worship songs appropriate for worship around scripture and sermon text as provided by the Pastor
- ~ Lead in musical worship on Sunday mornings

The members of the Worship Team are T. Dale Lynch, Matt Limbaugh, Patti Rowe, Austin Finley, Elizabeth Stone and Jackie Kay. Matt & Patti are co-chairs.

Article VIII: Organizations, Standing Committees, and Ministry Teams, Section F. Ad Hoc Teams (Page 9)
