**REPORT FROM THE
ADMINISTRATIVE MINISTRY COUNCIL...**

The AMC approved, at their February meeting, a recommendation by the Missions and the Properties and Space Committees to tear down the structure on the Keown property. We, as a church, purchased the property in the fall of 2020. The home was inspected by construction experts and it was determined that it would not be cost effective to renovate the building. The home will be demolished and the property will be cleaned up to get it in good condition as part of the FBC campus. The Missions Committee is continuing to look at possible uses for the property for missions.

Also, the AMC approved a recommendation from the Music Team to ask Robert Beaver to serve temporarily as our Supply Music Minister through May 30, 2021. He will begin March 14.
