For the next several months we would like to focus on the senior saints at Belton First Baptist Church. Today’s spotlight is on Marvin and Gaynell Kay. As the war ended, Marvin spent Thanksgiving Day, 1945 in Nagasaki Harbor. Later, on December 7, 1945, he went to Nagoya and Kure, where he saw Hiroshima. The Kay’s have enjoyed “Square-dancing” as a hobby. They have one son, Carroll. Reading the Bible through has been a constant encouragement to this fine BFBC family!
